Hello,

Please find below a brief consultation response from Brake:

Brake supports the introduction of a Clean Car Standard and Clean Car Discount. These would be important steps in reducing carbon emissions from light vehicles, and would encourage people to buy cleaner vehicles.

We would like to see a more stringent target, in line with the European Union, over a longer time period if necessary so that a longer-term plan to reduce emissions from light vehicles is identified.

We support penalties for suppliers who fail to meet their targets and for misreporting as part of the Standard.

Brake supports the Clean Car Discount, but would like to see this extended to other types of low-emission transport e.g. e-bikes. Doing so would help to incentivise people to choose these cleaner transport options and switch from car use, which has environmental, health and safety benefits. Brake would also like to see the discount applied to new types of transport in future without the need for major changes to laws or standards, and sees this Standard and Discount as an opportunity to future-proof this area.
